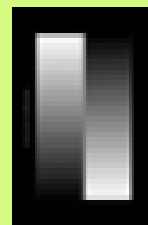

Past Times in Interlochen

“EARLY TRANSPORTATION”

During the heydays of Interlochen, the lumbering industry consisted of operating sawmills, cooperage mills, shingle mills and the business of transporting the best logs by railroads or by floating them down the Betsie to Frankfort sawmills. There they were sawed into lumber to ship across Lake Michigan to Chicago to help in the rebuilding of the city after their great fire.

Besides the Pere-Marquette and M&NE railroads, we were blessed with fine teams of horses and “Big Wheels” to get the logs out of the woods and swamps. Other forms of transportation and shipping on the Betsie, Duck Lake and Green Lake were several steam tugs. The biggest was the Betsie which eventually sunk. Parts of this tug were recently found by skin divers exploring the lake bottoms. I have some of the metal parts of this tug (the shaft rudder and propeller and other parts). I also have the paddle from a steam “Sternwheeler”. Shouldn’t we be doing something to display these artifacts along with pictures and stories and obtain a State Historical Marker so local people and tourists alike can enjoy?
